Construction Specifications:

Hydrant House

- Used to enclose hydrant and store fire fighting equipment
- 16 gauge **galvannealed*** steel
- Spacious “walk-in” design features an open floor and two sturdy storage shelves
- Single door furnished with heavy-duty hinges AND locking handle
- Unit is shipped unassembled with assembly instructions
- Finish: red baked acrylic enamel



* **Galvannealed steel:** The preferred coated steel for use in architectural applications.
 • Coated in zinc, heated to over 1000° F so iron is pulled from steel.
 • Iron mixes with zinc coating, making it harder, more scratch-resistant, uniform appearance.
 • Galvannealed steel bonds better with paint, and it is better for welding.
